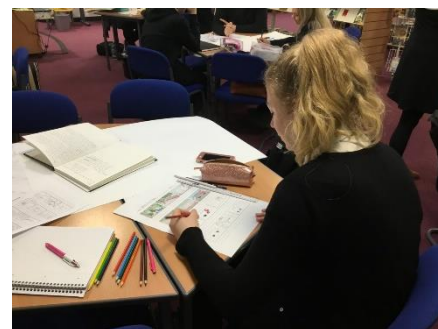
Students said that:
