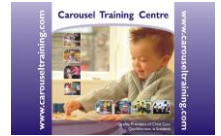

STEP INTO CHILDCARE - TRAINING FOR CARE

Employability Fund stage 3 programme for people aged 16+ who wish to work in Childcare.



Whilst on the programme you will be given support to develop your employability skills and will start to build your knowledge of working in childcare.

The programme is currently delivered on Zoom and we will aim to secure placement experience when this becomes available. During the virtual sessions you will complete Certificate of Work Readiness Units and, if placement opportunities are not available, National Progression Award Units in Childcare.

On successful completion of the programme, suitable participants will move into employment in childcare with the aim of becoming a Modern Apprentice. Other participants will be work-ready and will be supported to make informed choices for their next steps.

REFRESH TRAINING AND WORK EXPERIENCE - FRESH START

ReFresh is an 8-week course for individuals aged 16+ who are ready to address and remove barriers to employment. The course offers the opportunity to gain a number of qualifications - SQA Personal Development Award, SQA Communications (Speaking and Listening) and an Adult Achievement Award.



The course is a combination of practical and written work and focuses on developing confidence, interpersonal skills, communication and teamwork skills. Individuals will learn how to put these skills into practice within Fresh Start's practical services – the warehouse and within our PAT testing service, garden, community kitchen, homewares shop and pantry.
