## How can you help?

- $\checkmark$  Try and make doctors, dentist and hospital appointments out with the school day
- ✓ Ensure pupils return to school after an appointment if unavoidable
- ✓ Encourage and monitor pupil attendance
- ✓ Encourage pupils to arrive at school for 8.25am every morning

## Attendance in school is directly linked to greater achievement.

When attendance falls below 85%, pupils on average achieve at least 1 grade less per subject.
